

Overview: The research office designed a survey in collaboration with the health center to gather student's use of drugs and alcohol. The survey was emailed to a random sample of 2,000 students enrolled after census in spring 2024 with a valid email address and first name on file. The survey was sent on April 29 with a reminder sent on May 6, and closed on May 10. This resulted in 108 responses with 104 consenting that they are at least 18 years old and agree and willing to participate in the survey for a response rate of 5.2%.

Key Findings:

- The majority of survey respondents report not using tobacco, alcohol, cannabis or other drugs in the past 3 months.
- Of students who reported using a substance in the past 3 months, alcohol was used at the highest rate with 21% of respondents using alcohol 1-2 times, followed by 13% 3-9 times, all other respondents reported not using alcoholic beverages.
- Tobacco was reported to be used 1-2 times by 10% of respondents, followed by 3-9 times for 4% of respondents, all other respondents reported not using tobacco or other nicotine delivery products in the past 3 months.
- Cocaine was used by 2% of respondents 3-9 times and by 1% of respondents 1-2 times, all other respondents reported not using cocaine in the past 3 months.
- The majority of respondents identified as female (55%) while 38% identified as male which resulted in a higher response rate for females students than in the total student population in spring 2024 (49%).
- The majority of respondents identify as Asian or Asian American (44%) which is similar to the student population (45%). 19% of respondents identify as Hispanic or Latino/a/x, which is lower than the student population (25%).




