
HOW TO BEGIN AND NAVIGATE YOUR SIMNET COURSE

Starting Your Course:




Navigating Your Course (overview):

When you enter your course, you will see the following screen. Examine the screen below which describes the SimNet Interface and how to use it.




Step 2: Starting Your Assignments: To begin your course, follow these steps NOW:




Navigating a Lesson (overview):


Don't perform these steps yet, please read the following instructions first: Examine the screen below to learn how to complete your lessons. Lessons are interactive and composed of **three Parts:**

Part 1: **Teach Me**Part 2: **Show Me**Part 3: **Let Me Try**






Step 4: Complete the **Show Me** part of your lesson NOW.




Step 5: Complete the **Let Me Try** part of your lesson NOW.




Step 6: Take Your Exam:
