

## Health Verification

### IMMUNIZATIONS AND TB SCREENING

You must provide the ISP office with written documentation of **TB** (Tuberculosis) test and immunization of **Rubeola** (Measles) and **Rubella** (German measles) **by the second Friday of your first quarter at De Anza College.**

*Immunizations from your home country without appropriate official documentation will **NOT** be accepted.*

**TB**(Tuberculosis): you must bring the following types of written proof to the ISP office:

- ❖ A skin TB test reading (positive or negative) within last 90 days of arrival to the U.S.

**REQUIRED: Bring** an official Doctor/Clinic document/letter with the information stated above.
- ❖ If the TB skin test is positive, bring chest x-rays results

**Immunizations** (Rubella & Measles): you must bring the following types of written proof to the ISP office:

- ❖ medical records, and/or,
- ❖ immunization record(s), and/or
- ❖ an official note from a health care provider stating the date and type of immunization administered

**REQUIRED: Bring** an official Doctor/Clinic document/letter with the information stated above.

**NOTE:** the above written proofs must be original. ISP staff must clearly be able to see an official document/letter from the doctor/health care provider or facility your TB test, chest x-rays (if needed) and immunizations were done.

If you must retain the original for your records, ISP staff must see the original medical document first and keep a copy for our file.

If you have never had these immunizations and/or TB test, or cannot obtain the required proof, ISP has made arrangements for you to have them done through the De Anza College Health Services. We will give you more information during the Orientation Program.
