
De Anza College English/Writing and Math Success Rates by Cohort


Figures 1 and 2 shows the percent of students starting in a basic skills course who are successful in the next course.

For English writing (EWRT), Asian students show the highest course success rates. Course success rates for African American students, tracked for three years, decreased for the 2007-08 cohort.



As shown in Figure 2, the course success rates of students starting in a basic skills Math course are about the same as students starting in an English writing course. The success rate of White students is higher in English writing courses than in math, while the opposite is true for African American students.
