<u>Overview</u>

Please find in this memo some highlights regarding F1 students enrolled at De Anza College during the 2011 spring quarter:

- The number of international students at De Anza College with an F1 visa increased slightly from 1,632 in spring 2010 to 1,675 in spring 2011.
- The percentage of international students who enrolled full-time increased by 2% from spring 2010 to spring 2011.
- International students from China continued to make up the largest proportion of international students from spring to spring.
