Subject: ESL 251 Supplemental Instruction Analysis

1. Success rates of students enrolled in ESL 251 and ESL 253 were captured between summer 2009 and winter 2011. Success is defined as A, B, C, and P in each course.

- 2. Persistence rates of students enrolled in ESL 251 and 253 were tracked from quarter to quarter. Persistence is defined as the number of students enrolled in a subsequent term divided by the number of students who started in the first term.
- 3. Students enrolled in ESL 251 were identified as students who were provided supplemental instruction in fall 2010 and winter 2011 by the instructors. The two terms were combined due to the small sample in each quarter. This resulted in 18 supplemental instruction students. Success rates of students in supplemental instruction were compared to students in the same class that did not receive supplemental instruction.
- 4. Persistence rates of the supplemental instruction students were tracked from fall 2010 to spring 2011.
- 5. Retention rates of supplemental instruction students and non supplemental instruction students in fall 2010 and winter 2011 were calculated. Retention is students who successfully passed (A, B, C, D, P, I) the course divided by the total number of students enrolled in the course (A, B, C, D, F, P, NP, I, W).

Important highlights include:

Success Rates

- Success rates in ESL 251 were above 84% in 2010M, 2010F and 2011W
- Success rates for ESL 253 were above 74% in 2010M, 2010F and 2011W
- Supplemental instruction students had higher success rates in ESL 251 (94%) than students in the same course that did not receive supplemental instruction (84%).

Persistence Rates

- Students enrolled in ESL 251 and 253 in fall 2010 were tracked to winter 2011. Of the 332 students in fall 2010, 293 were enrolled in winter 2011 in any course, this resulted in a persistence rate of 88%.
- Students enrolled in ESL 251 and 253 in fall 2010 were also tracked to spring 2011. Of the 332 students in fall 2010, 267 were enrolled in spring 2011 in any course, this resulted in a persistence rate of 80%.

- Of the 9 supplemental instruction students who started in fall 2010, 8 were still enrolled at De Anza College in winter 2011 as well as spring 2011, this resulted in a persistence rate of 88%.
- Of the 9 supplemental students who started in winter 2011, 8 students were still enrolled in spring 2011, this resulted in a persistence rate of 88%.

Retention Rates

• Students enrolled in the supplemental instruction element of ESL 251 had a course retention rate of 94% compared to 84% of students in the same course that did not receive supplemental instruction.
