SUBJECT: EWRT 1A for Non-Native Speakers Research PRELIMINARY RESULTS

As requested, I have compared the grades given to students in EWRT 1A sections for Non-Native Speakers (NNS) with student grades for all other EWRT 1A sections for a particular term. Students in these sections were then tracked backwards to see if they had taken a specific list of courses and also tracked forward in time to see if they had completed the courses typically next in the sequence.

## Major Observations

> Students in NNS and ESL 5 sections had a higher pass rate (grade of A, B or C) than students in comparable EWRT 1A sections (see Figure 1 below). Between 2003W and 2004F the aggregate rates were $91 \%$ for NNS, $91 \%$ for ESL 5 and 80\% for EWRT 1A.
$>$ For NNS, ESL 24, 72 and 126 were the courses most often taken by students prior to EWRT1A. For all other EWRT1A sections students most often took EWRT100B, READ100 and 101. Please note though, that the tallies in Figure 2 are duplicative in that a student may be counted, for example, as taking both READ 100 and EWRT 100B.
> Figure 3 indicates that students passing EWRT 100B passed EWRT 1A (regular sections) at about the same rate as students that placed into EWRT 1A (had no pre-course on file). Students completing an ESL course did better than other students in EWRT 1A, with NNS sections posting the highest pass rates.
> It appears from Figure 3 that a higher percentage of NNS students had taken a pre-course rather than those placing into EWRT 1A, as compared to the regular section students. \{NEED TO VERIFY\}
$>$ Students completing NNS and ESL 5 sections had a higher pass rate when attempting EWRT 1B or EWRT 2 when compared to students in the regular EWRT 1A sections (see Figure 5).

## Data Issues

$>$ The data does not consider which course a students starts with. It may be that there are differences between students that start in READ100 versus EWRT100B.
$>$ Since there are only few NNS sections taught by 2-3 faculty members, individual grading biases can not be ruled out as resulting in higher pass rates for EWRT 1A. However since these students do go on to do better in the next course, the bias argument can be seen to carry less wait.
$>$ The analysis does not consider the demographics of students such as ethnicity, F1 Visa status, and enrollment status (full versus part time). Research has indicated that F1 students, enrolling full time, have higher success rates than other students. F1 students may make up of higher percentage of the NNS population than found in regular EWRT 1A sections.
