## De Anza College - Cancelled Courses - Winter 2020

In winter 2020, De Anza College cancelled 92 sections with enrollment over two predetermined cancellation dates – December 16, 2019, and December 20, 2019. Over these dates, 768 unique students were dropped, but by census (1/21/20), 99% (759) of the students who were dropped were still enrolled in other classes or other courses, for a loss of 9 total unique students. Tracking the same courses they were dropped from when the course was cancelled, 11% (88) re-enrolled in the same course but a different section.

Methodology: All sections that were dropped on the pre-determined cancellation date(s) or the dates provided for those courses with low enrollment and no longer have any enrollment the following day as of the drop dates were tracked. This report includes only those sections that were cancelled due to low enrollment. Other classes were cancelled over the quarter, but are not included in this report, these reasons may include: wrong course number, new time/day, no instructor to teach the class, instructor on medical leave, Honors section removed, change of instructional method. Further, in other reports of cancelled sections, a course plus a lab may be counted as two cancelled sections, this report would count that course as only one section, as the same students are enrolled in the lecture and lab sections.

Enrollment for all students who were dropped from a course were tracked from the last predetermined drop date where frozen data was available (12/22/19) through census (1/21/20). Students re-enrolling in the same course were tracked over the same timeframe but only if they enrolled in the same subject and course number.
