SUBJECT: New Faculty Hires by Ethnicity

Per your request, the figures below contain data on new fulltime faculty hired between July 1, 2000 and June 30, 2005. The data was extracted from the live HRS system in September, 2005 and is based on hire date rather than tenure class.




Figure 2 New Fulltime Faculty Hires by Fiscal Year of Hire Date* and Ethnicity Percent of New Hires Each Fiscal Year - Fiscal Years 2000-01 thru 2004-05

- ➤ Of the 96 new fulltime faculty members hired over the period, 52 or 54% were White. (See Figures 1, 2, and 3).
 - o During the same time period, the student population was 25-30% White.
 - o In Fall 2000, 71% of the teaching faculty were White and in Fall 2004 67% were White.
- As indicated by Figure 4, 59% of the new hires had some previous employment with the district (based on a broad comparison of "original" versus "current" hire dates).
- ➤ Over the period, 58% of the new hires were women, which is slightly higher than the De Anza student population. (Figure 5).
