Zip Code Groupings by Ethnicity

- African American student headcount decreased the greatest in the Cupertino area (14%). Followed by the San Jose Other with a 10% decrease.
- Filipino headcount decreased by 2% in the Cupertino, Sunnyvale area and the San Jose East of 880 area, and remained flat in the San Jose Other area.
- Latino/a headcount decreased 5% in the Cupertino, Sunnyvale area and the San Jose East of 880 area.

- International students with F1 or FZ visa status enrolled in Spring is at 2,101 slightly down from 2,138 the previous Spring.
- Females comprise 45% of the international students with F1 or FZ visa status.
