TracDat	Nuventive has requested that we propose changes that we would like to see implemented.  Mary will forward the following to them after establishing that the ability to make the change does not already exist on TracDat:  1. The need to go to one tab to enter method of assessment and to another for the assessment itself is clumsy and faculty do not remember the steps. Is there a way to keep these tabs but have one to speak to program level (unit) outcomes and the other to course/service level outcomes?  2. In data summaries, we would prefer Enhancement to be a box and not see the little blue click. We find the multiple enhancement and follow-up ideas not helpful. Faculty prefer a follow-up as a new assessment.  3. Need to be able to generate reports of what is not assessed.  4. Drag & Drop ability for uploading documents.  5. Drag & Drop ability for moving order of custom text boxes on a page.  6. Multiple tabs to store at least six years' of program review.  7. Assign button in two places is confusing. Can it be optional?  8. Box on Data Summaries for Resources needed for enhancements (this can be done "in house").
