
## Assessment by Guided Self-Placement


**Humanities and Liberal Arts Majors:** Four options, depending on academic goals and Guided Self-Placement results

### Statistics




Note: STAT C1000 was previously known as MATH 10

### Pathway to MATH 1A



Notes:

- A transfer level math course placement (STAT C1000 or MATH 11, 12, 31, 44 or 46 and higher) allows you to register for any course that has a prerequisite of intermediate algebra, or other developmental math.
- De Anza's Math Department launched the two course Precalculus series (MATH 31 > MATH 32) in 2020. See your counselor if you took MATH 41, 42 or 43 in the past.
- All students are eligible for MATH 1A, effective July 1, 2025; other classes may be recommended.
