

Lead for all ICC events and club involvement.

Marketing

Responsible for all ICC marketing & social media engagement

Equity

Model and implement equity-centered initiatives & support

Eligibility Requirements



Enrolled at De Anza with minimum 8 quarter units.

*Keep in mind that International students must have at least 12 units per quarter

Student not on academic/administrative probation, maintain minimum GPA 2.0 (current, quarterly, and cumulative)

Current DASG cardholder (at application, election, throughout term)

May not be voting member or intern of DASG, club officer, or Student Trustee

Limit of 3 terms serving ICC

1	Held during ICC Representative Meetings
2	Candidates give an introduction and a short speech, followed by Q&A from ICC Officers
3	Active clubs vote through their ICC Representatives present at the meeting
4	A candidate must receive a majority vote (50% + 1) to be elected
5	If no candidate reaches a majority and there are 3 or more candidates, a runoff is held between the top two
6	Runoff vote takes place at the same ICC meeting
7	Votes are counted and results are announced to the council

How to get elected?

Election Notes

- Chair of Marketing candidates must submit a design/video portfolio sample
- Equity & Legislative Liaison is appointed, not elected
 - Selected by the outgoing DASG Chair, Equity Liaison, and ICC Advisor
 - Appointment is based on application + interview process
