XB12, Instructional-Material-Cost, has been added to the California Community Colleges Management Information System Data Element Dictionary. The codes, A, B, C, D, Y, are defined below and the implementation date for the new code is summer 2022. 	healthcare. Nevertheless, Governor Newsom's veto message again
	cited cost as the justification for his veto."
