**Subject:** Withdraw Survey – Spring 2018

The withdraw survey was distributed to students who withdrew from one or more of the courses they were registered in during spring 2018. 237 respondents completed this survey.

## Reasons why Respondents Withdrew from a Course

- 28% (67) of survey respondents were not satisfied with the instructor
- 16% (38) indicated a personal issue outside of school
- 11% (27) were not passing the course or getting the grade they wanted
- 11% (27) indicated their job schedule did not allow them enough time to be successful
- 7% (17) indicated the course's day or time no longer fit their schedule
- 5% (11) indicated other reasons than the ones that were listed
- 5% (11) found it hard to find time to spend on the class
- 4% (9) indicated financial issues
- Other reasons for withdrawing from a course were cited at rates of 3% or less
