

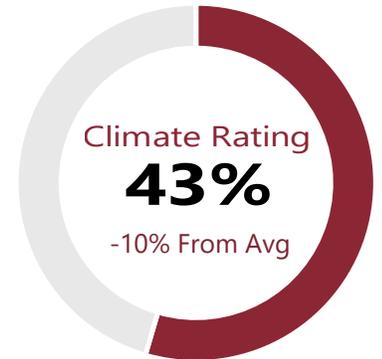
# CAMPUS CLIMATE SURVEY - SPRING 2025

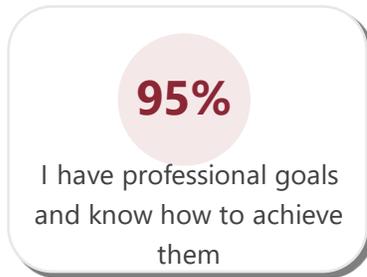
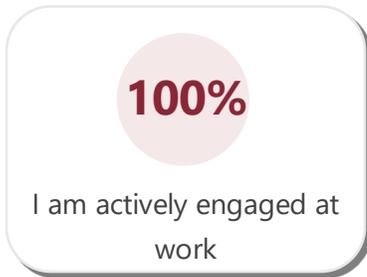

TOTAL FULL-TIME FACULTY RESPONDENTS



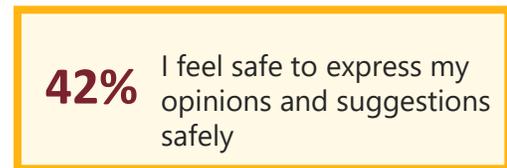
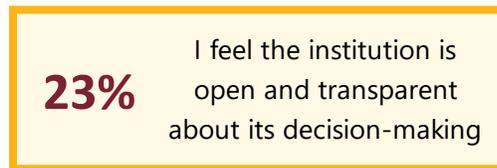
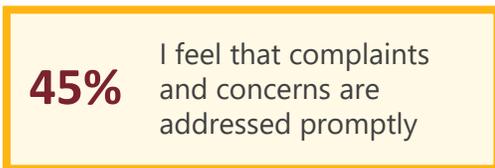

Statements with the highest rates of agreement or strongest indication of effectiveness

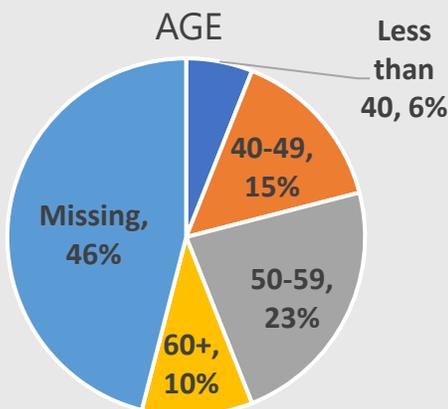
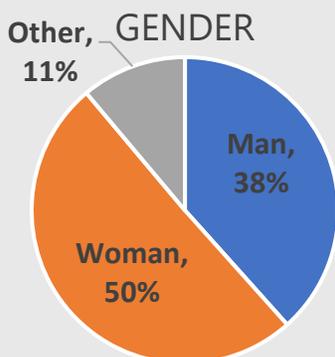

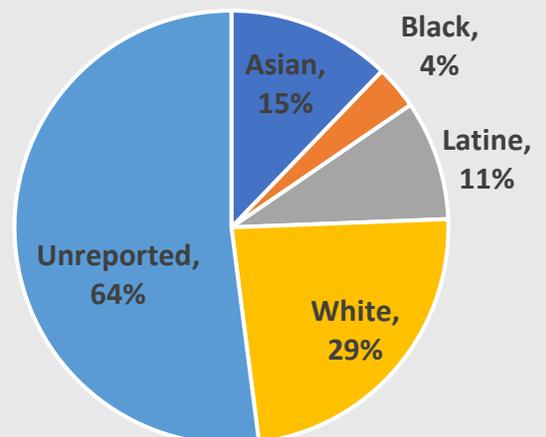
Statements with the lowest rates of agreement or weakest indication of effectiveness

## TOP RATED RESPONSES

Positive responses above 70

### Campus Safety **87%**

On campus when it is light out, 96%

In the restrooms on campus, 90%

In my workspace/classroom, 88%

In the parking lots on campus, 86%

### Active Engagement **87%**

I am actively engaged at work, 100%

I have professional goals and know how to achieve them, 95%

I am focused on trying to achieve my professional goals, 92%

I feel connected and part of the community, 89%

### Work Satisfaction **62%**

My work is meaningful to me, 89%

I'm contributing professionally in ways I value, 79%

### Institutional Effectiveness **60%**

Enacting curricular/academic state mandates, 77%

Implementing equitable student retention efforts, 73%

Promoting student well-being, 72%

Implementing equitable student outreach and recruitment efforts, 71%

## AREAS FOR IMPROVEMENT

Positive responses below 50%

### Decision-Making Process **57%**

I feel the institution is open and transparent about its decision-making processes, 23%

The administration genuinely considers the viewpoints of representatives in these processes, 30%

I believe these decision-making processes effectively include diverse perspectives and promote equity, 39%

### Equal Opportunity **56%**

Be considered for job advancement opportunities, 38%

Express my opinions and suggestions safely, 42%

### Executive Leadership **33%**

The executive leadership team members operate transparently, 26%

Provide timely responses to concerns and questions, 27%

Recognize the accomplishments of others, 33%

Foster innovation and creativity, 42%

### Institutional Effectiveness **60%**

Implementing equitable employee retention efforts, 45%
