




1. Select "Student Success Analytics"






ACCESSING YOUR PROGRAM REVIEW DATA SHEET

1. Select "Program Review." Then select "Program Review Data Sheet."





1. On the left-hand navigation panel, click on the arrow next to the desired <u>college name</u>. In this example, "De Anza College" is selected.




2. Click on the arrow next to the desired <u>division name</u>. In this example, De Anza College's "Creative Arts" division is selected.






3. Click on the arrow next to the desired <u>department name</u>. In this example, De Anza College's "Dance" department is selected.



4. On the top right-hand corner of the department's program review data sheet, click on the PDF icon. The PDF will automatically generate and likely will be downloaded to your local desktop "Downloads" folder. Open the PDF, and print if needed.





SPECIAL UNIT GROUPINGS AND SPECIAL PROGRAMS/LEARNING COMMUNITIES

- 1. In some instances, program review data sheets are housed under the "Special Unit Groupings" section (see left-hand navigation panel) because their data reflect select courses. For examples:
 - De Anza College's Creative Arts special unit groupings are Animation, Film/TV Production, Film Studies and Screenwriting.
 - b. Foothill College's Kinesiology & Athletics special unit groupings are Kinesiology, Personal Trainer and Sports Medicine.





- Additionally, some program review data sheets are housed under the "<u>Special</u>
 <u>Programs/Learning Communities</u>" section (see left-hand navigation panel) because their data
 reflect student-level or section-level designations. For examples:
 - a. To select CalWORKs data sheet, be sure that "CalWORKs students" is highlighted.
 - b. To select First Year Experience data sheet, be sure that "FYE sections" is highlighted.
