Course Outline: I shall cover Chapters R, 1 to 4, and partially chapter 5. It covers differentiation and its applications; Exponential and logarithmic functions, and their derivatives; Integration and its applications. This is intensive and fast pacing course, requiring lot of practice to have clear understanding of the concepts.
