Course Outline: Student learning outcomes: Outcome 1: Evaluate real world situations and distinguish between and apply exponential, logarithmic, rational, and discrete function models appropriately. Outcome 2: Analyze, interpret, and communicate results of exponential, logarithmic, rational, and discrete models in a logical manner from four point of view - visual, formula, numerical, and written. It covers topics like Properties of exponents, Solving Linear and Absolute Value Inequalities; Rational Expressions, Functions and Equations; Radicals, Radical functions, and Rational Exponents; Exponential and Logarithmic Functions; Circles; Sequences and Series. It is an intensive course, requiring ten to fifteen hours of study time out side the class.
