

# How Teachers Use Social Networks



- + <u>Facebook</u> (social network website): class groups, discussion posts, reminders, and creative projects.
- + <u>Twitter</u> (social networking and microblogging): class discussions, reminders, connections to the community.
- + <u>Google Docs</u> (web-based word processor): allows for real time collaboration, store and share documents.
- + <u>Tumblr</u> (blogging site): allows for group discussion on a topic or essay.

- + Myspace users more open to opposing view points (Pew)




### **Students: Benefits & Drawbacks**
