- 1. **COURSE TITLE Oil Painting I -** Arts 16A 4 Units
- 2. **COURSE DESCRIPTION** Introduction to oil painting with emphasis upon basic techniques related to

the medium itself. Course progresses from monochrome towards a full color spectrum, developing

skills of paint handling, color mixing, as well as aesthetic concerns of composition, imagery, and

expression.

3. PREREQUISITES: Arts 4A and English as a Second Language 4.

STUDENT LEARNING OUTCOME STATEMENT (SLO)

Students will develop and utilize critical thinking skills in their understanding of paintings from

several time periods, demonstrating this in three ways: aesthetically, technically, and philosophically.

4. COURSE OBJECTIVES:

- 1. Study color and composition through exercise and application.
- 2. Prepare painting surfaces--this will include the making of stretchers and the priming of these surfaces.
- 3. Develop skills in the use of underpainting, mediums, impasto textures, drybrush and scumbling techniques, and the use of various brushes and a palette knife.
- 4. Research ideas and develop plans in advance of class time, including all drawing information:

class time must be used for the execution of the painting.

- 5. Utilize critical thinking skills to critique and analyze your own art works and the work of other students.
- Visit an art museum/gallery/space and write about applications of color principles, composition,

and painting techniques by a specific artist. You will also be asked to comment on the institution itself.

5. METHODS: Instructor demonstration, discussion of materials, class lectures, slide presentations of

relevant painting styles past and present, individual projects, personal and group critiques.

6. **GRADING:** Evaluation will be based primarily on the completion of all assigned studio projects.

Important additional consideration will be given to participation in class discussions and critiques

every approx. every two to three weeks. You must present at least one finished painting per

critique.

Written evaluation: Submit a one-page written evaluation of your work at each critique. You may

discuss the selection of the image, the process and technique as well as the problems you

encountered and overcame in your paintings.
