FALL	<u>UC</u>
	 9/15 Deadline <u>Complete your UC Transfer Academic Update (UC TAU)</u> reflecting summer final grades, and Fall in progress class schedule. After deadline, contact each UC campus or log in to your UC student portal for instructions on notifying campus of any more changes.
	<u>CSU</u>
	 Mid October Deadline Apply for ADT if you intend to transfer to a CSU in Spring with completion of the AA-T/AS-T to initiate graduation and ADT eVerification. De Anza will send an email with more info. Attend an ADT Application Clinic or drop-in to apply Monitor ADT Verification. Verification will occur electronically on your behalf if you turn in your Request for Degree for your ADT by the mid-October deadline If the status on the Check Status page of your CSU application is "pending verification" or "not verified" on November 1st for Spring Transfer connect with your counselor or Transfer Center for Support on ADT Verification.

	 Research housing options CSU and UC campuses will announce transfer admission decisions. Keep your grades and GPA up as admissions offers are contingent on you finishing well. Date varies, check your portals Commit to a school. This often costs money and is non-refundable, so decide carefully or ask about deferment considerations. CSU: Submit Intent to Enroll to the CSU
	 UC: Submit <u>Student Intent to Register (SIR) to the UC</u> Review to-do list, <u>send final transcripts</u> and/or test scores to the school you will be attending, check portal for due dates.
	After saying yes to your university and paying the enrollment fee, request <u>GE</u> <u>Certification</u> .
	Share your Good News with the Transfer Center.
	• <u>Celebrate your achievement</u> ! Sign-up to participate in end of the year celebrations!
	Sign up for the <u>Transfer Achievement Celebration</u> to receive your Transfer Achievement Medal.
WINTER	Send final transcripts and/or test scores to the school you will be attending, check portal for due dates.
	Attend transfer student orientation provided by your transfer university.
	Finalize housing arrangements.
	Arrive at your transfer destination, your new home university!
